

MGCC RACING REGISTER  
STANDING ORDERS

This document to be presented and voted on by all eligible MGCC Racing Register members at the first Special General Meeting in 2014.

The following procedure be adopted for all future Annual General Meetings for election of Register office bearers.

All elections are by secret ballot.

An independent Returning Officer be appointed.

An Independent Chair Person be appointed to conduct the AGM.

The AGM be held as soon as practicable after the final racing event of the year but no later than 31 December.

For the elimination of doubt the MGCC Constitution shall apply to the conduct of all the Register activities.

Register members must be notified by all reasonable available medium, predominantly e-mail, of the date of the AGM 21 days prior the date of the AGM.

Proxy votes may be lodged with the Returning Officer or with an eligible member up until the opening of the AGM.

Notices of motion with a proposer and seconder must be lodged with either the incumbent Captain or Secretary no later than 14 days prior to the AGM.

If more than one nomination is received for Captain a secret ballot must be held.

The Committee shall consist of a maximum of six persons plus the Captain. If more than six nominations are received for committee a secret ballot shall be held.

The newly elected Captain and Committee shall take up their positions immediately after the AGM.

Voting eligibility;

Must be a member of the MGCC Victoria, Melbourne Centre.

Must have raced in a calendared round of the Register Championship within the last three years.
